**NOMINEES ANNOUNCED FOR RICH COUNTY  
JUSTICE COURT VACANCY**

**Randolph, UT**—The Rich County Nominating Commission has selected four nominees for an upcoming vacancy in the Rich County Justice Court. The position will replace Judge Ross McKinnon, who will retire effective Jan. 1, 2017.
